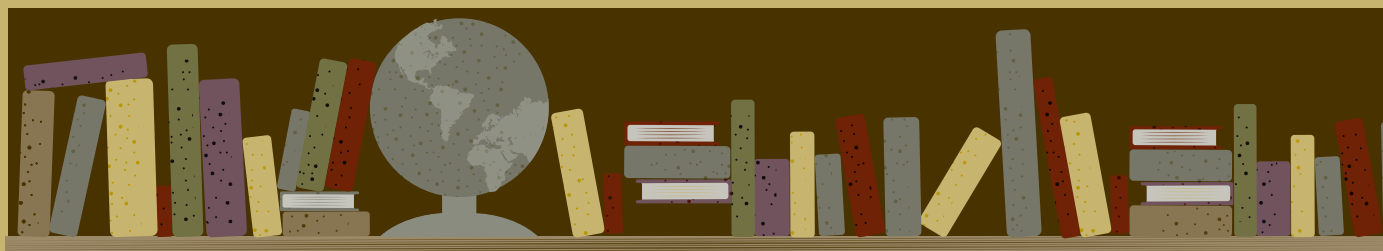
# Family Weekend September 8 - 10, 2017
